Manfred A. Lange received a PhD in Geophysics from the University of Kiel, Germany. After a Post-Doctoral Fellowship at the Californian Institute of Technology in Pasadena, California, USA, he moved to the Alfred-Wegener-Institute for Polar and Marine Research (AWI) in Bremerhaven, Germany. He was the Director of the German Global Change Secretariat, an institution under the Federal Ministry for Research and Technology. He has been Director of the Arctic Centre at the University of Lapland in Rovaniemi, Finland. Manfred Lange was appointed Full Professor in Geophysics and was the Director of the Institute for Geophysics at the University of Münster, Germany. Since 1998, he was also the Director of the Center for Environmental Research (CER), a central institute at the University of Münster. Manfred has been coordinator/participant of numerous projects under the Fourth, Fifth and Seventh Framework Programme of the European Union and the European Science Foundation and coordinates various nationally funded research projects. Since September 2007, he is the founding Director of the Energy, Environment and Water Research Center (EEWRC) of the Cyprus Institute. Research areas are assessment of climate change impacts through integrated assessment and specification of possible mitigation and adaptation strategies with a particular focus on natural resources and ecosystem services.
